project size: 4¼"x5½"

you'll need

Papers & Embellishments

- Card stock (Stampin' Up!®): Chocolate Chip; Brushed Gold; Vanilla.
- Bookplate (We R Memory Keepers™).
- Brads (We R Memory Keepers™).
- Gold Stickers (Ranger).

Tools & Supplies

- Stamps: Kim Hughes Silhouette Blooms I (Cornish Heritage Farms); Boho Blossoms (My Favorite Things).
- Classic Stampin' ink pad (Stampin' Up!®): Chocolate Chip.
- Nestability Dies (Spellbinders).
- Wizard Embossing & Die Cutting System (Spellbinders).
- Cuddlebug™ (Provo Craft®).
- Textile Folder.
- Brayer.

what to do

- 1 Cut Chocolate Chip card stock to 4¼"x11"; score and fold in half.
- 2 Cut Brushed Gold card stock to 4"x5¼". Die cut scalloped rectangle in center of gold mat. Place mat in textile folder and emboss. Roll ink over embossed frame with brayer.
- 3 Cut Vanilla card stock slightly smaller than gold mat. Stamp image in center.
- 4 Place gold frame over stamped image; attach brads to corners.
- 5 Stamp sentiment on Vanilla card stock; trim to fit bookplate. Attach bookplate to mat.
- 6 Attach layers to card front.
- 7 Add Stickers to flower centers.
