

# chillin' snowman *card*



project size: 5"x5"

## you'll need

### Papers

- Card stock (Stampin' Up!®): Olive; Red; White.

### Embellishments

- Button.
- Ribbon (Stampin' Up!®).
- Hemp.
- Stickers™ (Ranger®): Red; Crystal.

### Tools & Supplies

- Stamps (My Favorite Things): Baby It's Cold Outside.
- Classic stamp pads (Stampin' Up!®): Black; Soft Sky.
- Classic markers (Stampin' Up!®): Black; Red.
- Markers (Copic).
- Nestabilities™ (Spellbinders®).
- Cuttlebug™ (Provo Craft®).
- Crop-A-Dile (We R Memory Keepers).
- Brayer.
- Dimensional stickers (Stampin' Up!®).

## what to do

- 1 Cut Olive card stock to 5"x10"; score and fold in half.
- 2 Create two Red and one White mats; adhere together. Adhere ribbon to corner of layer; adhere layer to card front.
- 3 Use black ink to stamp snowman image on White card stock. Sketch in ground and trees; when satisfied, go over sketch marks with thin black marker. Color snowman with markers; trim.
- 4 Cut thin strips of card stock for arms; adhere to card. Use black ink to stamp hat and gloves on White card stock; color; trim and adhere to snowman.
- 5 Emboss snow on White card stock. Brayer Soft Sky ink over embossed snowflakes. Adhere snowman layer to embossed layer with dimensional stickers.
- 6 Use Nestability™ die and Cuttlebug™ to make scalloped frame from Olive card stock. Cut a slightly wider rectangle from Olive card stock. Mat frame on rectangle; adhere. Mat snowman layer on Olive layer; adhere. Attach ribbon to layer.
- 7 Use Black ink to stamp sentiment on White card stock; cut out. Punch hole with Crop-A-Dile. Thread hemp through hole and button. Attach to image layer with dimensional sticker.
- 8 Adhere image layer to card base.
- 9 Apply Red Stickers™ to trees and Crystal Stickers™ to snow.
