

# groovy floral swirl *card*



project size: 4¼"x5½"

## you'll need

### Papers & Embellishments

- Card stock (Bazzill Basics): Green Tea; Princess; Apricot; Brown; Dragonfly.
- Patterned.
- Brads (Making Memories®): Turquoise; Orange.
- Flower Brad (Cactus Pink).
- Ribbon.
- Cork (Creative Impressions).
- Brown ribbon (Offray).
- Buckle (Nunn Designs).
- Fabric scraps.

### Tools & Supplies

- Rhonna Farrer stamps (Autumn Leaves).
- Colorbox® Chalk ink pad (Clearsnap): Chestnut Roan.
- Die Cuts (Spellbinders): Flower Creations.
- Wizard Die Cut Machine (Spellbinders).
- Large Scallop Scissors (Fiskars).
- Glue Dots (Glue Dots International).
- Notch and Die Tool (Basic Grey).

## what to do

- 1 Cut Green Tea card stock to 6"x12". Measure 4½" from left side; score and fold toward center. Measure 2" from right side; score and fold toward center. Trim edge of left flap with patterned scissors. Use notch and die tool to cut notch in right flap. Tuck scalloped edge under notch.
- 2 Stamp flourishes.
- 3 Die cut flowers from cardstock, fabric and cork using Layered Flower die.

Layer together various shapes and materials to create flowers. Bind with brads. Use Glue Dots to adhere flowers to card.

- 4 Tie ribbon around buckle. Use Glue Dots to adhere buckle to card flap.
